- Complete a separate proposal for each basket submitted.
- Attach two 4: X 6: close-up matt or glossy color photo(s) of each basket to the upper right hand corner of the proposal. Photo background must be white.
- Include one CD with the image of each of the proposed baskets. Identify each basket on the CD. DO NOT CROP PICTURES. Also on the CD include a word document with the name of the basket, teacher name and the description.
- If your submission is not your original creation, please obtain permission from the creator to teach the proposed basket and give credit where it is due in the basket description.
- Include a stamped self-addressed 4” X 9” envelope.
- You must be a current member of the NCBA to be eligible to teach.
- Proposals must be received no later than March 10, 2012.
